

Waverley Lawn Tennis, Squash and Sports Club

JUNIOR BYELAWS

Junior members of Waverley are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

- Junior members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Junior members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Junior members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions, or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Junior members must wear recognised tennis or squash shoes and appropriate clothing (coloured is allowed as well as white) for the respective sports. Black or dark-soled shoes and tennis shoes are not permitted on the squash courts.
- **Junior members playing squash must wear protective eyewear which meets the British standard BS7930.1**
- Junior members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Junior members must abide by the court booking rules which are posted on the notice boards.
- The snooker room and sauna may only be used by a junior member when accompanied by an adult. Junior members may not use the gym unless under the supervision of a Club coach. Junior members aged 16 or over may, at the discretion of the Committee, be allowed to use the gym unsupervised.
